Instruction and Curriculum Support, Shelly Wiebe, NGPS Learning Services Coordinator

Ms. Shelly Wiebe, Learning Services Coordinator, provided the Board with an update on the Division's work within the new curriculum and instructional support.

As per Alberta Education's directive, the new curriculum for English Language Arts and Math is being introduced in all NGPS Kindergarten through Grade 6 classrooms this school year.

Additionally, Pat Hardy Primary, Fox Creek and Oscar Adolphson Primary are all piloting Alberta's new Science curriculum. Piloting gives NGPS teachers the ability to provide feedback on the curriculum to the government.

Teachers, principals and leadership have been hard at work supporting the new curriculum roll-out:

- through Provincial grant funding and Division funding, all NGPS teachers will receive 4 additional Professional Development (PD) days this year for extra support focused on instruction and the new curriculum
- JUMP Math and online and other literacy resources have been purchased and are being utilized to support instruction in the classroom
- to date, the Division has had 14 working days with teachers where teachers could connect and collaborate with grade level partners and work together within the new curriculum.


Moving forward, Wiebe emphasized the Division's plan to continue to support teachers, build capacity and stay connected.
