Welcome to Career Exposure Summer Camps 2023.

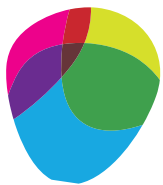
Earn high school credits and gain hands-on experience while honing a skill, exploring a passion, or trying out a new interest.

Cyber Security Training

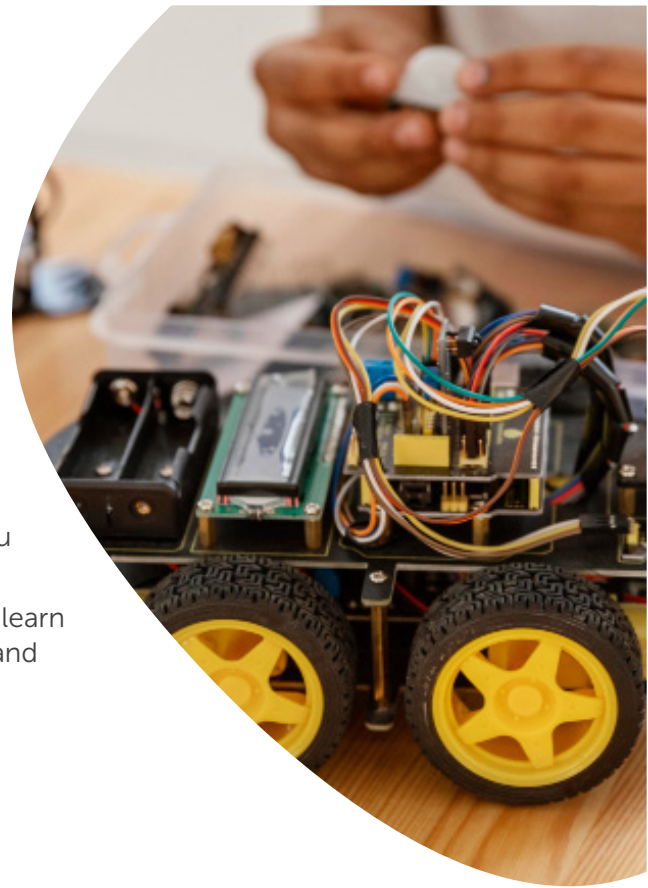

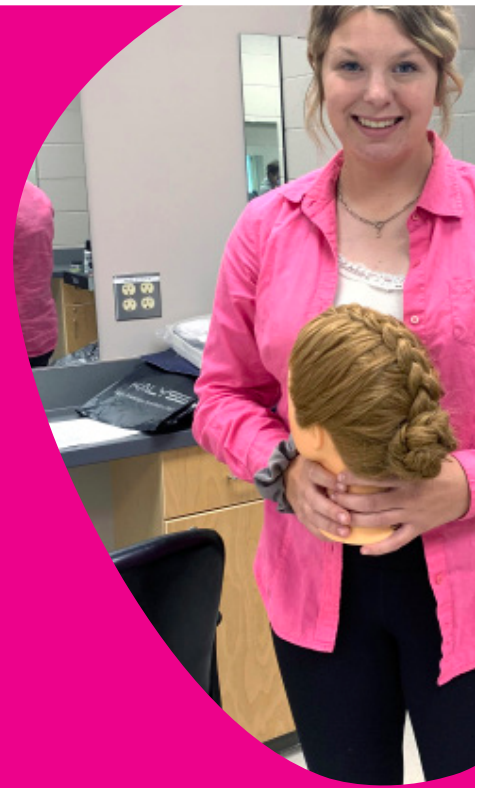
Aesthetics & Hairstyling

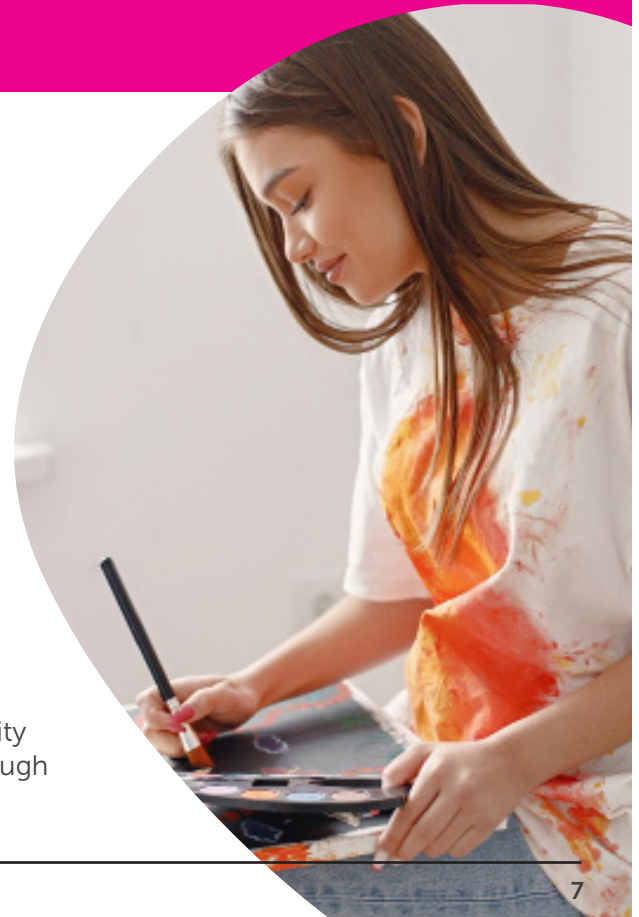
Art & Design
