

- b) Adjusts ward and subdivision boundaries to align more directly with transportation areas; and
- c) Provides for the amalgamation of Ward 1, Subdivisions 3 and 4 with two (2) Trustees to be elected at-large, and the amalgamation of Ward 3, Subdivisions 2 and 3 with two (2) Trustees to be elected at-large.

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The Board has looked extensively at current ward boundaries and Trustee representation. Amalgamation of subdivisions in some wards gives more balance with some Trustees appointed at-large.


