Mayerthorpe Jr/Sr High School (MHS) International Field Trip

New York, Broadway and the Arts! MHS teacher, Katherine Lewis, requested the Board's approval to take MHS students on an arts and history tour of New York city during spring break of 2026. Lewis shared how big the love for the arts is in our rural communities, and how she is eager to share with students what the arts on a professional scale looks like. Students will attend two Broadway shows and be guided through multiple historical sites, connecting to curriculum outcomes in both arts and history.

Hilltop Jr/Sr High (HTH) School Electric Vehicle Challenge

Paul Marinus, teacher at Hilltop Jr/Sr High School, spoke to the Board about an exciting learning opportunity coming up for HTH students. Pending approval of the Board, a small number of interested HTH students will compete in an electric vehicle challenge in Merritt, British Columbia, at the end of the May. The competition includes building their own electric vehicle (EV) cart, and racing their cart against up to 40 other schools from Alberta, B.C., Ontario and the U.S.

The competition aims to elevate interest in electric vehicle technology and encourage student interest and excitement about building, fabrication and the electric vehicle industry. Hilltop is ecstatic to have a local sponsor for the opportunity in Tri-Terra from Whitecourt, and former HTH student, Justin House.
