Provisions for Lines of Sight within School Buildings

Background

Maintaining lines of sight within school buildings is a proactive measure that provides added security and safety for both staff and students.

Procedures

1. In areas where staff and students interact, internal school structures that provide lines of sight, such as windows and glass door panels, will not be completely covered except for:
 - a. Emergency situations;
 - b. Pre-approved educational need for special events or lessons;
 - c. Other situations authorized by administration for privacy reasons.

2. If a staff member makes a request to have a line of sight blockage improved where they interact with students, the maintenance department will make every effort to fulfill the request with consideration of budget constraints.
