Provisions for Lines of Sight within School Buildings

Background

Maintaining lines of sight within school buildings is a proactive measure that provides added security and safety for both staff and students.

Procedures

- 1. In areas where staff and students interact, internal school structures that provide lines of sight, such as windows and glass door panels, will not be completely covered except for:
 - a. Emergency situations;
 - b. Pre-approved educational need for special events or lessons;
 - c. Other situations authorized by administration for privacy reasons.
- 2. If a staff member makes a request to have a line of sight blockage improved where they interact with students, the maintenance department will make every effort to fulfill the request with consideration of budget constraints.
